Dear Parents and Carers,

2022 Excursions / Incursions

I have had discussions with a few families of late regarding our school and incursions or excursions. The below table reflects the 'events' we have had and are still having this term. As you're all aware, the new parent payment policy has made organising and paying for excursions a little more difficult. Where in the past a curriculum excursion had to be paid for but now, it does not. If we hold excursions and we only receive 30% of the payment, then the school must pay the rest of the balance out of our own funds. These funds will not last forever and so far this year we are certainly not receiving 100% of excursions / incursions (curriculum based) paid for. As camps are not curriculum based but opt in only, they are not shown on this table. CSEF Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund applications

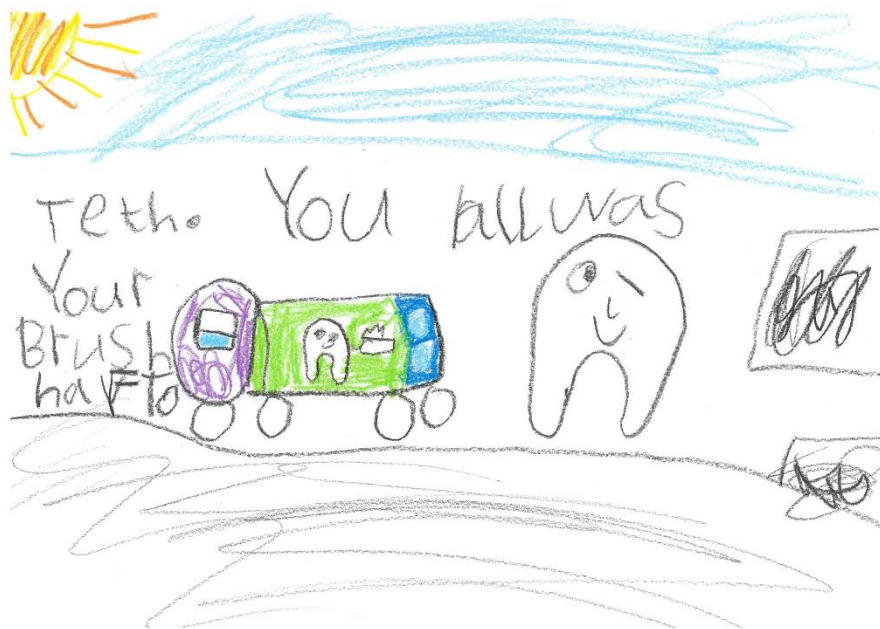
The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you have a valid means-tested concession card, such as a Veterans Affairs Gold Card, Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible.

The payment amounts this year is \$125 for eligible primary school students. Payments are made direct to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions and sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

If you are yet to submit your 2022 application or still need to complete your application by presenting your concession card **please see the office by Thursday 16th June, as this is the last opportunity for 2022 to receive this funding.**


