### Principal's Report

#### Student Dress Code Policy

It is timely that we remind all our students and families of some sections of our Student Dress Code Policy.

- **Jewellery and cosmetics**

Students are not permitted to wear decorative jewellery to school. Stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears, and watches, are the only acceptable jewellery. Cosmetics may not be worn at school. Only clear nail polish is permitted.

- **Hair and Sun safety**

Shoulder length or longer hair is to be tied back to help restrict the spread of nits and lice and for student safety.

Once updated, our Dress Code Policy will also reflect that students are not to have cosmetic nails such as fake or acrylic nails as a health and safety risk to themselves and others.
