Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to every member of our school community for all your hard work, patience, understanding and support during this term. In line with the Premier and DET's guidelines, there will be a staggered start to the term. - Monday 5th October – remote learning continues for P-6 students and only essential service workers children will be supervised
- Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October all P-2 students return, but enter through designated gates
- Presently, Monday 26<sup>th</sup> October should see all P-6 students learning on site.

Students will have their temperature taken and any child whose temperature is above 37.5 will be isolated and need to be immediately collected from school. Once again, no parents will be allowed on campus. Please phone or e mail the office and someone will come out to meet you.
